BLUES & HALF BLUES CONSTITUTION

MINIMUM STANDARD REQUIRED FOR BLUE/HALF BLUE

To be eligible for nomination of a Blue award the club member should satisfy the following conditions:

1. He/She should have competed in 75% of first team matches for at least two seasons, except in exceptional circumstances¹.
2. If selected, he/she should be available to compete for the University before any other club.
3. Must have achieved the standards set below.
4. Must have represented Edinburgh University at the Scottish Universities Team Championships, if so required.

Notes

¹ – In accordance with point 1 of the Fencing Club's Blues constitution, the committee of the time will define the term 'exceptional circumstances' based on each case. Exceptional circumstances will not include acts such as essay deadlines, but the committee will take into account any compulsory part of a nominee's course that has caused the nominee to not fulfill point 1 of the constitution.

² – In the case where the percentage is not a whole number the ceiling function will be in place i.e. rounds up to the next whole number e.g. top 20% = 9.23 will become top 10 places.
